



The first winery vermouth with 100% Verdejo character

Cuatro Rayas Winery has just released “61” Vermouth, the first 100% Verdejo aperitif, a new drink produced precisely in the so-called birthplace of Verdejo, the town of La Seca in Valladolid. “61” becomes the first vermouth available in the market claiming its Verdejo roots. A white wine that has been macerated with a careful selection of botanicals resulting in a mahogany colour vermouth with low bush aromas.

- 👄 Balanced mouthfeel with a pleasant long bitter finish, evoking the same balsamic reminiscences found on the nose.
